### LENTZCAPING, INC. OPENS ITS DOORS

Warrington, PA (June, 2009) On Saturday, May 30, 2009, Lentzcaping, Inc., a local landscaping firm, held an “Open House” for the community to show off their new office complex and waterfeature displays. The day was sunny and bright and the mood festive, as an estimated 350 people stopped by to marvel at the “makeover” which took place at 2139 Bristol Rd in Warrington.

Visitors enjoyed the multiple ponds and pondless waterfalls on display, as well as a new paver patio featuring a fire pit and sitting wall, outside grill & fireplace. They were also introduced to an innovative environmental sustainability initiative--a Rain Water Harvesting system, designed by Aquascape, Inc. This system captures rainwater from the office roof, stores it in a submersible basin where it will be eventually re-used to maintain the plants and shrubs which adorn the office complex.

In addition to the displays, there were activities for the kids to enjoy, including pony rides, a moon bounce, and many of the kids were found wading into the signature pond (pictured right) to swim with the fish and try to capture the tadpoles as they swam through their legs.



In keeping with their “giving back” philosophy within the community, Lentzcaping management sponsored two charitable events during the Open House. The first was the presentation of two mature liberty elm trees for replanting. One was presented to Warrington Township and the second to the Girl Scouts Troop #21618 (pictured left) under the leadership of Susan Curtis. The Troop plans to donate the tree to the Kutz Elementary School in Doylestown, as part of an environmental awareness project.

The second charitable event was the sponsorship of an Alex’s Lemonade Stand, where visitors got to enjoy a cold cup of lemonade for a worthy cause--Alex’s fight against childhood cancer. Alex’s Stand was able to raise \$150.00 during the day.
